Nature's Point Bar Service Agreement

Nature's Point is one of the few facilities which allow Clients to provide their own alcohol saving thousands of dollars on their reception. If the Client decides to purchase alcohol for the event the following agreement must be signed and Nature's Point bar services must be retained. This agreement is binding and all the payments and paperwork must be provided to Nature's Point 30 days prior to the event.

The bar package price is \$7.00 per person and includes the following items listed below:

- *4 hours of service*
- *A TABC certified bartender**
- *Bar set up and take down*
- *Sodas*
- *Juices*
- *Mixers*
- *Ice*
- *Wine, beer and cocktail cups*
- *Napkins*
- *Limes/oranges*
- *Water*

**All parties over 150 guests will require 2 bartenders and a service fee of \$250 will be added.*

*** Beer kegs are not permitted on the premises.*

In order to assure that all laws concerning consumption of alcohol are adhered to by Nature's Point staff, clients and guests, the following guidelines have been established.

Times for serving alcohol must be specific when contracting with Nature's Point. All the paperwork, payments and planning details must be given to Nature's Point event manager 30 days prior to the event. The bar open times may not exceed 4 hours.

Nature's Point has the right to ID anyone at any time prior to serving alcohol. In some instances, Nature's Point may even use an identification stamp on the hand for ID purpose. The law states that no one under 21 years of age will be served alcohol. If Nature's Point staff observe anyone underage drinking alcohol, the employee has the right to confiscate the drink.

Nature's Point has the right to refuse anyone service who, in Nature's Point opinion, has had too much to drink. If any guest gets out of line, Nature's Point will contact the host and ask them to have the guest removed from the premises. Getting "out of line" includes being hostile or aggressive to any Nature's Point staff. Host is responsible for any damages to Nature's Point property due to guest who may have had too much to drink.

All alcohol is to be consumed on the premises. No guest is permitted to bring in alcohol. Nature's Point reserves the right to close the bar due to failure to comply with the guidelines. Nature's Point will announce a last call for alcohol 30 minutes prior to the end of the event.

At the conclusion of the event the bartender will box up any remaining alcohol and give it to the event manager. Once the guests have departed the alcohol will be returned to the Client or Designee.

Lessee agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Owner, Owners Employees, Agents, Subcontractors or any person present, from any and all actions, claims, demands, losses, damages, or injuries arising from any act, omission or negligence of the Owner, Owners Employees, Agents, Subcontractors, or any person present, for any injury or damage to persons or property incurred during clients use of the Facility, on or about the Facility, or arising out of the Lessees use of the Facility in connection with this agreement. Lessee agrees to defend the Owner, at client's expense, from any such claims, demands, or causes of action with an attorney reasonably satisfactory to the Owner.

This Agreement is binding. No agreements, verbal or otherwise shall be honored or deemed valid unless a formal amendment to this contract is made and signed by both parties.

If this agreement is signed in the name of a corporation, partnership association, club or society, the person signing represents and warrants to the Owner that he/she has full authority to sign such contract, and in the event he/she is not so authorized, that he/she will be personally liable for the faithful performance of this contract.

Signature by the Owner or Owners agents shall be regarded as acceptance by the Owner of the above reservation for the Lessee's function.
